Part of the many colorful clusters nestled on the hills of Positano, this dream-like villa offers as many views of the sea as your eyes can grasp. Find here one of the milestones of the coast, a quintessentially Positano's mansion.

- The villa can accommodate up to 20 guests in 10 bedrooms and 14 bathrooms, of which
- 4 guests in the attic, with its 2 suites
- 1000 m2 of gardens and 350 m2 of panoramic terraces

Located in the most panoramic position of Positano, the extraordinary 500 m2 mansion comes with terraces, unique flair and views: the four-level villa, in fact, affords views of the scenic landscape from almost every angle. The interiors include a spacious living room, a dining area with sea vistas, a well-equipped kitchen and several rooms with terraces. On the sweeping grounds there's an infinity pool, a solarium, and a garden. Private, yet very close to the town center, this estate offers eight bedrooms decorated in elegant style with color-washed walls and frescoed ceilings, custom fabrics, and two extra family suites in a modern design. The home design, approached with research in the historical context, results in a classic style with stone, tiled floors, quality majolica-tiled kitchen and bathrooms, and marble. Vaulted ceilings lend an elegant feel to the interiors. Modern yet very comfortable, this is a sumptuous retreat full of light and a welcoming vibes. Each morning our staff will serve a generous continental breakfast on one of the villa sea view, panoramic terraces.

To celebrate the first evening at the villa, a welcome dinner will be served on the panoramic patio overlooking Positano. This house is perched on the highest point of Positano, almost directly above the sea. From here, guests are rewarded with magnificent views of the coast, the center of Positano, and the islands of Li Galli. The property is in fact conveniently located in Positano town, making it a good fit for guests who want to be close to commercial activities and visit other destinations during their holiday, it is perfect for sea-lovers, looking for extraordinary nature scenarios and great seafood. Close to the heart of the action, this property is also perfect for those who want to be near to restaurants, bars and love living an authentic Italian experience. Built in 1700 its current owners embarked on a meticulous renovation in 2013-2014, preserving 18th-century frescoes and installing top-of-the-line appliances. Spiaggia Grande, in the centre of Positano, is the biggest beach in town, home to numerous bars, restaurants and beach clubs: guests can walk down to this beach. They can also walk to Fornillo from Positano's Spiaggia Grande, via the "Lovers' Walk". Nestled in a bay, this little beach is surprisingly quiet and peaceful. Positano's rocky coastline is home to dozens of hidden beaches, which can only be reached from the sea, a boat can be arranged to this purpose.

Important

There is no car access to the house, 150 steps are necessary to reach the road and 70 steps are between the last access for authorized private cars and the entrance of the villa. It takes 10-12 minutes to get down to the bay of Positano and circa 30-35 minutes to walk back-up. Rooms inside the property are reached through stairs. Private parking is available on the bottom of Positano, starting at euro 40 per car per day, local vat is extra and mandatory.

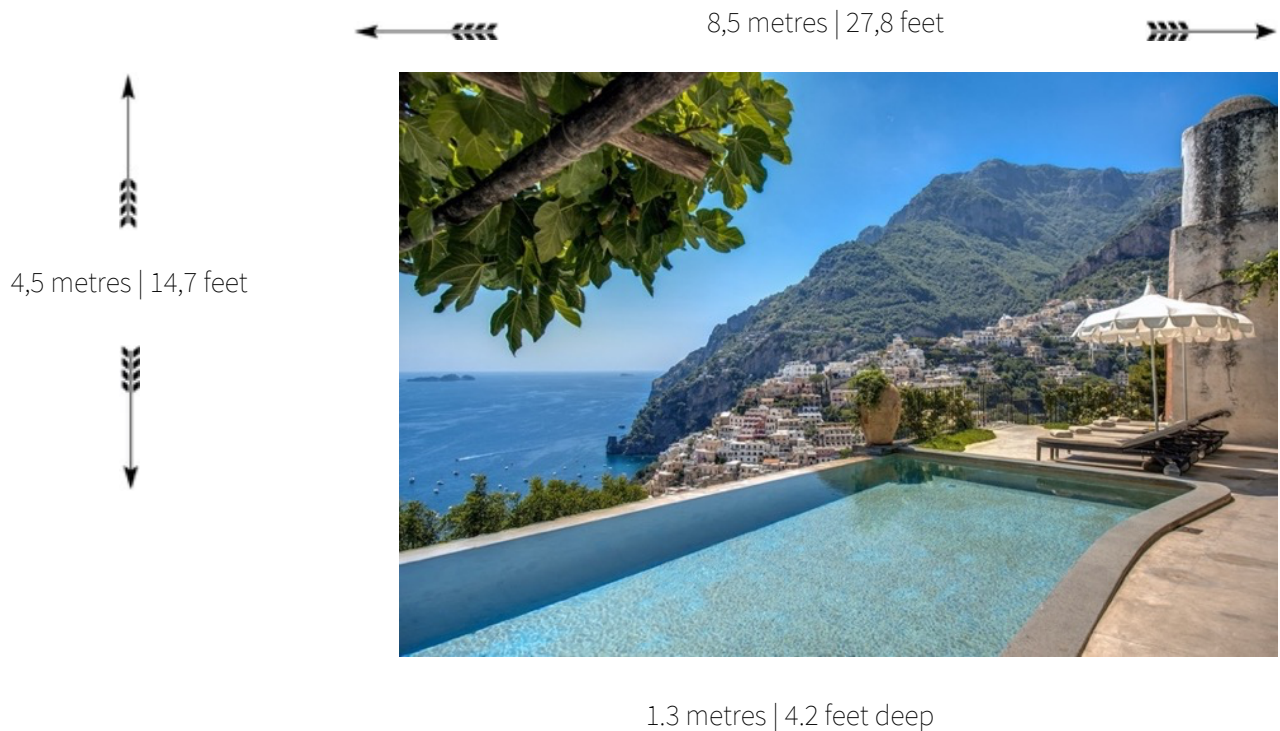

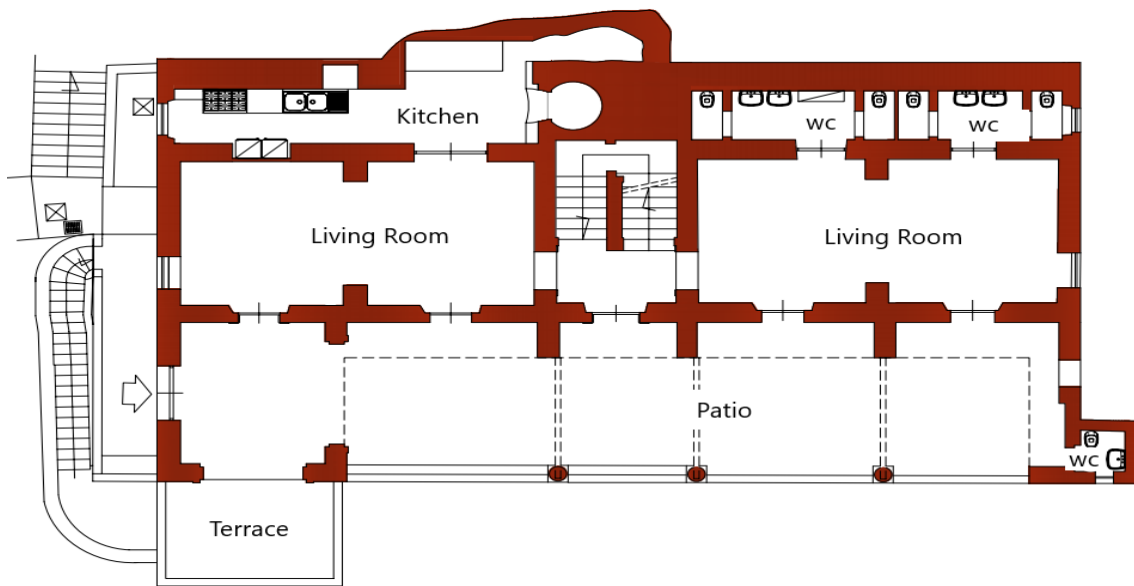


- Pool with infinity edge

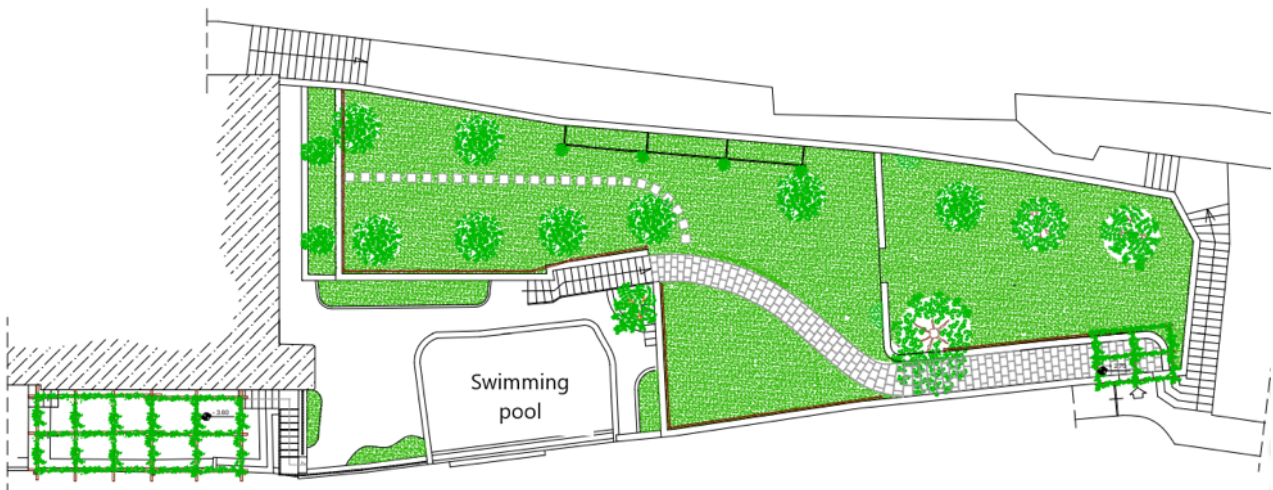

GROUND FLOOR



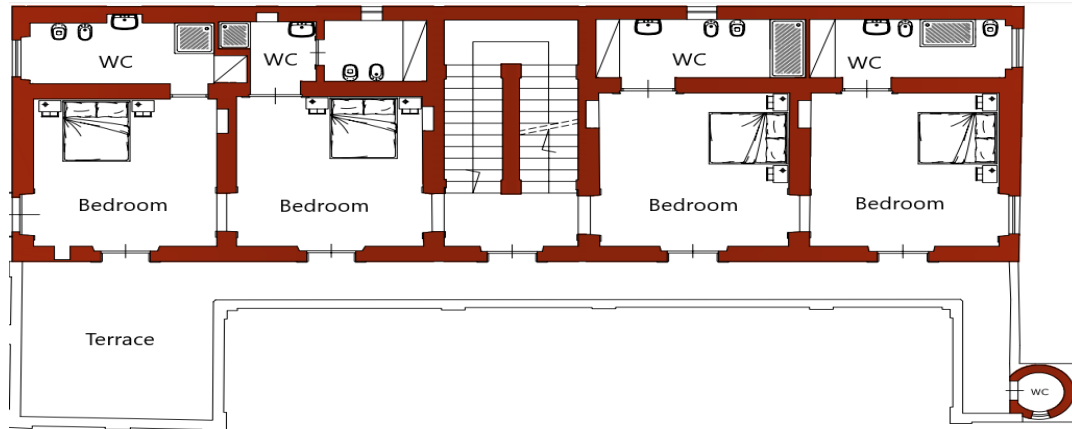

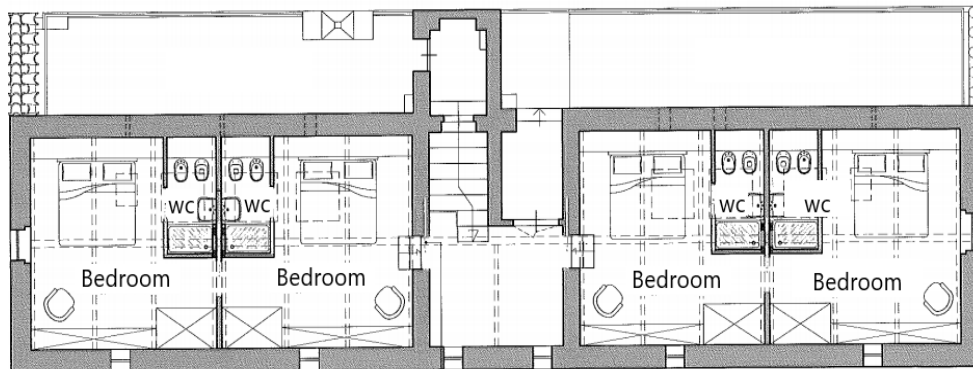

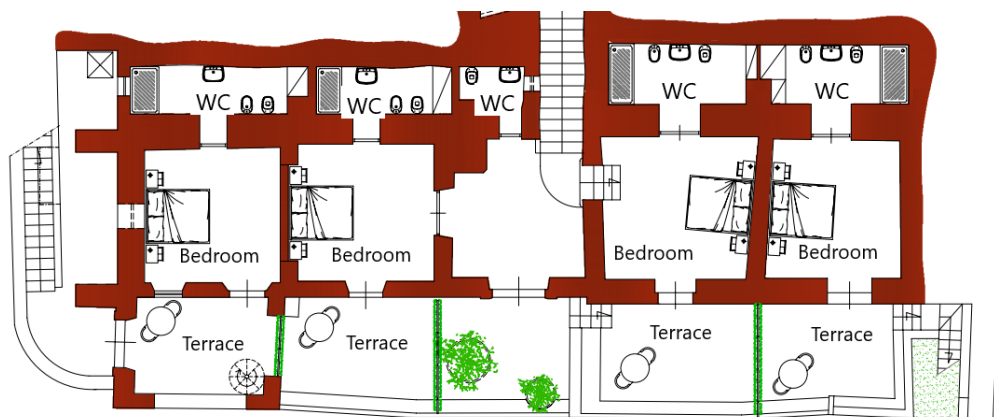

Amalfi Coast has great energy that comes from mixing history with so many different people from all over the world. And, as well as the restaurants, shopping and nearby nature, people's perceptions are also mesmerised of what a culturally rich area this is in terms of museums, architecture and art.

Time with family is celebrated in Italy, in fact almost every activity here is kid friendly. Each restaurant in the region offers a kid's menu and none raises an eyebrow when toddlers make an entrance in a Michelin starred spot. Several close-by restaurants and trattorias serve organic, local cuisine. We recommend the popular [Ristorante Max](#) 10 minutes away by walking. Do not miss [Cantine di Marisa Cuomo](#) for a wine-tasting. Food connoisseurs won't miss [La Sponda](#). Each restaurant in the region offers a kid menu and none raises an eyebrow when children make an entrance in a starred spot. A plethora of bars, cocktail bars, wine bars awaits you in Positano.

Bars and shopping

The closest bar for social activities is in [Hotel Poseidon](#) in a few minutes by walking.

Local Grocery Shop is in Cinque Giuseppina 300 m, Via G. Marconi and the Local Supermarket Di Giovanni Lucia 1,7 Km, Via G. Marconi, 312 84017 Positano. Amalfi or Sorrento are 16 km away, Naples 55 km and Salerno 66 km (90'). For the shopping, Via Chiaia in Naples is one of the most elegant streets in Naples, served by the famous "Funicolare". Via Toledo offers a wide choice for shopping, one can arrive here by getting off the Metro stop "Toledo", one of the most beautiful metro stations in Europe. In the chic Vomero district, via Scarlatti one finds high quality items. The street leads to the popular piazza Vanvitelli (metro station Vanvitelli or Medaglie d'Oro). Corso Umberto Primo is one of Naples' biggest streets, the real backbone of the City, like the famous Ramblas of Barcelona.

The local markets major in clothes, shoes, and household goods as well as the food stalls. You can buy good produce in the local grocers/greengrocers, you will see the local farmers delivering their goods daily.

La Sponda is arguably one of the prettiest restaurants on the Amalfi Coast, maybe even in all of Italy. With a view of the tiled dome of Positano's main church and out over the sea, the dining room has hand painted ceramic floors, leafy vines that wind up the whitewashed walls and, in the evening, the glimmer of 400 candles.
