





THE PROPERTY



Home décor

This residential villa, spanning two floors, is perched on elevated terrain, offering a breathtaking view of the Gulf of Naples and Vesuvius. Reflective of the local architectural style, the structure boasts large windows and white walls that imbue a nautical ambience while amplifying the visual impact. Adding to this, the property features an easily accessible rooftop, further augmenting the panoramic scenery together with the balconies in typical red clay cotto tiles.

Interior

The interior of the property is divided into two capacious levels, featuring Portugal pink marble and wooden flooring, respectively. The first floor comprises an expansive open-plan kitchen adorned with surfaces crafted from pink black

Brazilian granite, two commodious living rooms, and a veranda that provides a picturesque setting for breakfast or lunch, with copious natural light streaming through the vast windows. The second floor accommodates four bedrooms, each boasting a private balcony.

Exterior

The yard of the property is partyally a green garden with several trees like lemon, greapefruit, banana and palm. The pool area with his sun beds lies in the middle, while the outdoor bar and bbq is under a curved sun shade. All around are areas with tables and chairs, like the veranda on the side of the building. The garden is embellished with details crafted from pietra serena and natural local stone. A dedicated parking area is separated by verdant hedges.



Swimming Pool

- → The swimming pool measures 9 x 4 metres with 0,60 meters shallow to 1,60 meters deep
- → Have hydromassage jets, and a shallow end for getting in and getting out ease the access. Water uses a chlorine system purification
- → The pool is accessed through no stairs
- → Open from April 1 to Ottobre 30

Hot-tub

The hot-tub is set on the roof top and measures 2 x 2 metres, and it's 0,85 meters deep and is designed for 4 people. The tub features an electric

cover, and the water uses a Chlorine system. It is accessible through the balcony of Bedroom 1.

- The most awarded restaurants in the region are: Restaurant Mustafà in Marina di Seano is a renowned place for seafood specialities and traditional cuisine, together with a front see position, The Osteria Il Barrio is located within Vico Equense and provides an indoor garden with tables outside and exceptional cuisine where tradition can be enjoyed genuinely, surrounded by a citrus garden, Bistro La Tradizione is a small family-run restaurant that treasures traditional food above all, serving cheese, meat and wine using only products of the area
- Experience the Marisa Cuomo winery in Furore, recommended either for red and white wine tasting, visit the Pasta Factory in Gragnano,
- Visit the typical dairy Fernando De Gennaro shop, known in the area for his famous tasting of handmade provolone cheese

VERY IMPORTANT RULES

GENERIC

- 5. No smoking inside.
- 6. The Guest agrees to use the premises as a private holiday residence and not for any illegal or immoral purposes, or any other purpose without written authorisation.
- 7. The Guest agrees to take all reasonable care of the premises, including the pool and grounds, to leave the premises and the furniture in a tidy state of repair and condition, not to deface, make any alterations or additions to the interior or exterior, not to remove any of the furniture from its position and keep the furniture, soft furnishings, and equipment in their present state of condition, and/or cover the cost to replace with equal/similar articles, any items of furniture which may be found to be missing or damaged.
- 8. More hours of cleaning may be needed, depending on the size and habits of the Guest's group: the Local Partner's team will automatically increase hours and personnel if required, to be accounted as extra, to maintain the house clean and ready for current and upcoming guests.

- 9. Children must be supervised closely.
- 10. All services that are not originally included in the rent have an extra cost to be subtracted from the APA, among which we mention for simplicity and not for completeness: staff hours needed to complete assigned tasks, extra cleaning needed to keep the property in a tidy state, towels changed because requested by guests or left on the floor, damages caused, extra cleaning due to the presence of animals.
- 11. The Guest agrees not to play on the premises any musical instrument or sound equipment between 11.00 pm and 8.00 am or to be audible outside the Premises unless written authorisation.
- 12. The pool and gym equipment, where present, must not be used under the influence of alcohol or psychotropic medications.
- 13. The Guest agrees to permit the owners and their staff in charge access to the premises to deal with any maintenance or security issues.

FOR SWIMMING POOLS AND/OR TUBS

- 14. Children under seven years old or under four feet tall must be accompanied by a parent or responsible person in a swimsuit, including in the water; while in the water, the parent/responsible person must remain within arm's reach. Do not use inflatable or floating items in horizon/infinity pools
- 15. Please walk and do not run around the pool
- 16. Please be aware of the pool depth indicated either in the local documents and/or in the travel documents issued by the agency.
- 17. Please do not enter the pool with a copious amount of sun cream or tanning oil on your skin to avoid damage to the liner or protective layer or filters
- 18. No breakable items, e.i. glasses, bottles, etc., are permitted around the pool.
- 19. In case of an emergency, call your concierge immediately.
